BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Middleburgh Central School District hereby accepts the recommendation of the Superintendent to appoint Anne Young to a four (4) year probationary appointment as the Director of Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment in the Administrative tenure area, commencing September 1, 2017 and terminating August 31, 2021. Ms. Young holds permanent certification in School District Administrator (certificate # 193529)
 - B. Superintendent recommends approval of the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Middleburgh Central School District hereby accept the recommendation of the Superintendent to appoint Brittany Hecker to a four (4) year probationary appointment as a teacher of Literacy in the Remedial Reading tenure area, commencing September 1, 2017 to August 31, 2021. Ms. Hecker holds initial certification in Literacy (Birth-Grade 6) and Childhood Education (Grades 1-6). A necessary factor in consideration for tenure at the end of this probationary appoint, will be receipt of professional certification and fulfillment of all other requirements of the New York State Education Department, by Ms. Hecker, no later than the expiration date of her probationary appointment.
