

Running for the School Board

Petitions to nominate candidates for the office of member of the board of education are available to qualified district residents and may be picked up at the Middleburgh Central School District Office, 291 Main Street, Middleburgh, N.Y. 12122 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 4 p.m.

BOARD OF EDUCATION: QUALIFICATIONS, NUMBERS AND TERMS OF OFFICE

A Board of Education member of the Middleburgh Central School district must meet the following qualifications:

- A citizen of the United States;
- Eighteen (18) years of age or older;
- Able to read and write;
- A legal resident of the District for a continuous and uninterrupted period of at least one (1) year prior to the election;
- Cannot be an employee of the Middleburgh Central School District;
- The only member of his/her family (that is, cannot be a member of the same household) on the Middleburgh Central School District Board;
- May not simultaneously hold another incompatible public office including, but not limited to, Superintendent, Clerk, tax collector, treasurer or librarian, or an employee of the Board. However, a Board member may be appointed Clerk of the Board and of the District.
- Must not have been removed for a school district office within one (1) year preceding the date of appointment or election to the Board.

Number of Members

The Board of Education of the Middleburgh Central School District shall consist of five (5) members elected by the qualified voters of the School District at the annual election as prescribed by law.

Terms of Office

Members of the Board of Education shall serve for three (3) years beginning July 1 following their election and each term shall expire on the thirtieth day of June of the third year.
